Day 01: 18TH FEB, KOLKATA – CAIRO

By Flight & Road

Meals: Meals on Board & Dinner

Welcome to Smiles Per Miles Pvt. Ltd. Embark on a journey with us to one of the most popular destinations of the world named Ancient Egypt covering Cairo, Alexandria, Aswan, Luxor and Hurghada.

Arrive at Kolkata Airport three hours prior to the departure and complete all immigration formalities under the guidance of our Tour Manager before boarding the flight from Kolkata to Cairo.

Arrive at Cairo. After completing the immigration formalities, meet the local guide and board the coach. Proceed to the hotel for check-in, have dinner and stay overnight in Cairo.



Day 1

Day 02: 19TH FEB, CAIRO – ALEXANDRIA

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel in Cairo and leave for Alexandria. Alexandria was the greatest city in the ancient world built on the **Mediterranean Sea** by Alexander, the Great in 330 BC. Begin the tour with a visit to the **Catacombs of Kom El-Shouqafa**, the largest known Roman burial site in Egypt, with three tiers of tombs that could accommodate up to 300 corpses. It was later converted to be a public cemetery. Next visit the other important historical sites in the city including **Pompey's Pillar**, **Morsi Abu Al Abbas Mosque(outside)** and **Qaitbay Citadel(outside)**. The last stop of our tour will be **visit to Alexandria Library**. Later, check-in to the hotel, have dinner and stay overnight in Alexandria.

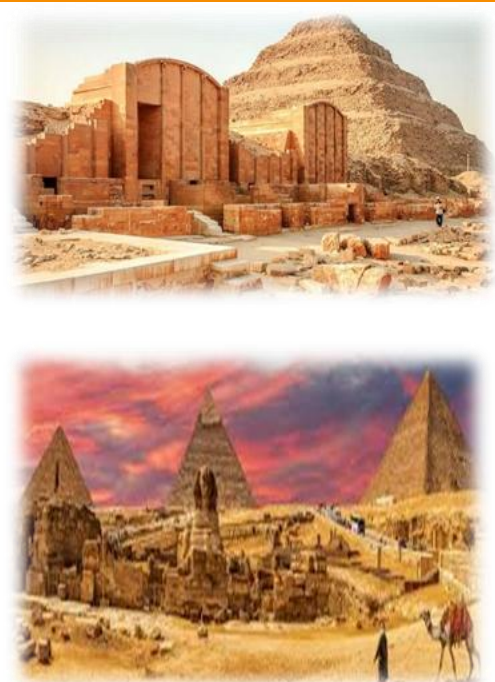
Day 03: 20TH FEB, ALEXANDRIA – SAQQARA – GIZA – CAIRO RAILWAY STATION

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner on Board

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel and proceed from Alexandria to Cairo and enjoy the tour starting with **Saqqara, the step pyramid complex** of the King Djoser. Aside from being home to Egypt's oldest pyramid, Saqqara is the largest archaeological site in the country. The Step Pyramid is the first known monumental structure made of stone anywhere in the world. As its name suggests, it is a series of six levels of stone decreasing in size as they ascend to about 200 feet or 60 meters in height. Then, proceed to **The Great Pyramids of Giza** - the Great Pyramid of King Cheops(Khufu), the pyramids of Chephren(Khafre) and Mykerinus(Menkaure), as well as the great Sphinx at Giza plateau. The Pyramid of Giza is famous as the oldest and only largely intact wonder of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. Built around 2600 BC as a royal tomb for Pharaoh Khufu, it was the tallest manmade structure for over 3,800 years. It is renowned for its immense scale, precise engineering, and surrounding mysteries.

Next, visit **Papyrus Institute** and **Perfume Factory**.

Later, proceed to Cairo railway station to board the **overnight Abela Sleeper Train** and accommodate in the **Elite Cabins** for an overnight stay. Dinner will be served on board.

Day 04: 21ST FEB, ASWAN STATION – PHILAE – ASWAN

Meals: Breakfast on Board, Lunch & Dinner

Breakfast will be served on board. Later, disembark from the train at Aswan Railway Station and proceed for an orientation tour of Aswan.

On arriving at Aswan, proceed to explore the **High Dam**, an engineering miracle constructed in 1960 to protect Egypt from the annual Nile floods, which is also an important source of water and electricity and the unfinished **Obelisk**.

Later, head for an excursion tour to **Philae Temple of Goddess ISIS**, the Goddess of magic and motherhood. It is one of the greatest temples in Egypt and the entire complex was moved from the original island (Philae) to Agilkia Island due to the floods and construction of High Dam. It boasts impressive, detailed reliefs depicting the myths of Isis, Osiris and Horus.

The Temple of Philae is a must-see attraction for many travellers, praised for its unique island setting and historical significance. The journey involves a scenic boat ride from Aswan, enhancing the visit.

Return to Aswan and check-in to the hotel for an overnight stay after dinner.



Day 05: 22ND FEB, ABU SIMBEL – NILE CRUISE

Meals: Packed Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner on board

Early in the morning, proceed for **Abu Simbel Excursion** on the day of **Sun Festival** with packed breakfast. We will depart in the early morning and drive for 3.5 hours to Abu Simbel. Upon arrival, visit the court of the Colossi Temple of Abu Simbel initially built by King Ramses II and recently saved from inundation of the Nile waters. The most spectacular aspect of this temple is its setting on the solid rock above the banks of the Nile River. It is believed that the axis of the temple was positioned by the ancient Egyptian architects in such a way that every year on February 22nd and October 22nd, the rays of the sun would penetrate the sanctuary and illuminate the sculptures on the back wall, except for the statue of Ptah, the god connected with the Underworld, who always remained in the dark. These dates are allegedly the King's birthday and coronation day respectively.

The Abu Simbel temples are two massive rock temples at Abu Simbel, a village in Nubia, southern Egypt, near the border with Sudan. They are situated on the western bank of **Lake Nasser** about 230 km southwest of Aswan (about 300 km by road).

The complex is part of the UNESCO World Heritage Site known as the "Nubian Monuments" which run from Abu Simbel downriver to Philae (near Aswan).

The twin temples were originally carved out of the mountainside during the 19th dynasty reign of the Pharaoh Ramesses II in the 13th century BC, as a lasting monument to himself and his queen Nefertari to commemorate his victory at the Battle of Kadesh. Their huge external rock relief figures have become iconic.

Next, **embark the Nile cruise**, check-in to the room and have lunch on board. Take rest in the cruise and relax for some time.

Later, enjoy the sunset from the deck of the Nile Cruise. Have dinner and stay overnight on board.

Day 5



Day 06: 23RD FEB, CRUISE – FELUCCA – KOM OMBO – NILE CRUISE

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner on board

Have breakfast in the cruise. Later, enjoy a sailing expedition on the Nile by the **Felucca** around **Elephantine Island**, the largest island of Aswan area and a major ivory trading center followed by the **Kitchener's Botanical Gardens** known for its rich array of subtropical, exotic and rare plants. On this day, you can also opt for the **Nubian Village tour** (optional – at additional cost).

After lunch on board, the cruise starts sailing to **Kom Ombo Temple** which is located in Kom Ombo town, 45km north of Aswan. The Temple of Kom Ombo is an unusual double temple in the town of Kom Ombo in Aswan Governorate, Upper Egypt. It was constructed during the Ptolemaic dynasty, 180–47 BC. Some additions to it were later made during the Roman period. The building is unique because its 'double' design meant that there were courts, halls, sanctuaries and rooms duplicated for two sets of gods. The southern half of the temple was dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek, god of fertility and creator of the world with Hathor and Khonsu. Meanwhile, the northern part of the temple was dedicated to the falcon god Haroeris, also known as Horus the Elder, along "with Tasetnetnofret (the Good Sister, a special form of Hathor or Tefnet/Tefnut) and Panebtawy (Lord of the Two Lands). Have dinner and stay overnight on board.

Day 07: 24TH FEB, EDFU – KARNAK & LUXOR TEMPLE – NILE CRUISE

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner on board

In the early morning, visit **Edfu temple** by horse carriage located 123 km north of Aswan on the West Bank of the Nile in Edfu, Upper Egypt. It is one of the most beautiful Egyptian temples distinguished by its huge splendid structure that blends Paranoiac and Greek architecture. Reach Esna and pass the **Esna Lock** and sail to Luxor.

Arrive at Luxor. Proceed to **Luxor Temple**, which is among a series of temples built in different reigns. It is the most contributed and functioning temple in the world and the greatest example of worship in the history dedicated to the God Amon, his wife Mut and their son Khonsu. In the evening, proceed to **Karnak Temple** and experience the magic of ancient Egypt with the **Light and Sound Show at Karnak Temple**. Have dinner and stay overnight on board.

Day 08: 25TH FEB, LUXOR – VALLEY OF KINGS – HATSHEPSUT TEMPLE – HURGHADA

Meals: Breakfast on board, Lunch & Dinner

In the early morning on this day, you can opt for hot air balloon ride (optional – additional cost). Check-out from the cruise and take a guided day tour of the west bank of Luxor. Visit the **Colossi of Memnon** which are remains of the Mortuary Temple of Amenhotep III. Next, visit the **Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at Deir El-Bahari** who was the daughter of Thutmosis I, who ruled Egypt for about 20 years during the 18th Dynasty (approximately 1490-1469 B.C).

Day 8



She is the only pharaonic woman who reigned ancient Egypt. Later, visit the **Valley of Kings** that stands on the west bank of the Nile, opposite Thebes (modern Luxor), within the heart of the Theban Necropolis where you will see the well-preserved tombs belonging to the kings of the new kingdom including the great ruler Ramses III, Mernptah and the tomb of the King Ramses IX. Next, have lunch in the restaurant.

After lunch, transfer from Luxor to Hurghada. Check-in to the hotel. Have dinner and stay overnight in Hurghada.

Day 09: 26TH FEB, HURGHADA

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Today, have a relaxed breakfast. Today the day is free to enjoy the resort, the Red Sea and the beach on your own. If you wish, you can also opt for submarine ride(optional) at your own expense.

Have lunch and dinner in the resort and stay overnight at Hurghada.

Dedicated to Ancient Egypt and its culture, society and artifacts, it is the largest museum in the world for a single civilization.
