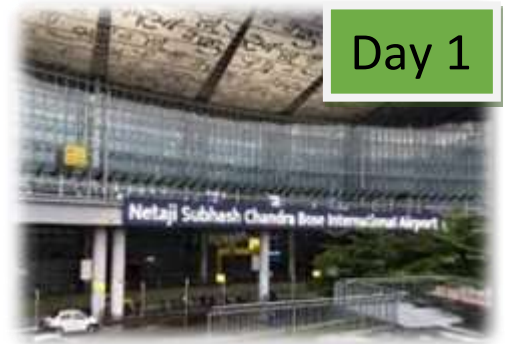
Day 01: 8TH JUNE: KOLKATA – DUBAI/ABU DHABI

By Flight

Next, visit **Cotswolds** what is often agreed to be one of the most beautiful areas in the whole of the UK. Day 03: 10TH JUNE: LONDON – STONEHENGE – BATH – BRISTOL – CARDIFF

Day 3

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, proceed for a tour of the stunning neolithic monument of **Stonehenge**, one of the most mysterious and fascinating of all megalithic monuments and uncover the secrets of this ancient monument at your own pace. The true meaning of this ancient, awe-inspiring creation has been lost in the mists of time. Was Stonehenge a temple for sun worship, a healing centre, a burial site, or perhaps a huge calendar? How did our ancestors manage to carry the mighty stones from so far away and then, using only the most primitive of tools, build this amazing structure? Surrounded by mystery, Stonehenge never fails to impress.

Day 05: 12TH JUNE: WINDERMERE – GRASMERE – KESWICK – LAKE DISTRICT AREA

Day 5

Meals: Breakfast & Local Dinner

Today, explore the fascinating **Lake District area** and enjoy the tour of Windermere and Grasmere in the heart of Lake District National Park in Cumbria which is well-known for its scenic beauty as described by various English poets who stayed there. After breakfast, proceed to enjoy a **cruise at Lake Windermere** from **Ambleside to Bowness** or vice-versa. Next, proceed to visit **Dove Cottage in Grasmere**, a charming village which was William Wordsworth's home from 1799 to 1808. Here, Wordsworth produced the most famous and best-loved of his poems, and his sister Dorothy kept her famous Grasmere journals. Later, visit **St. Oswald's Church**, the churchyard that houses the graves of the Wordsworth family and pass through Grasmere Village and Lake Grasmere.

Drive through **Keswick** and visit **Castlerigg Neolithic Stone Circle**. Next, proceed for an orientation tour of Lake District area.

Enjoy a photo stop at **Queen's View** that lies at the heart of **Perthshire** overlooking **Loch Tummel**.

Reach **Fort Augustus** and enjoy a **one-hour cruise in Loch Ness**. Loch Ness is a lake in the Scottish Highlands that's famous for the Loch Ness Monster, also known as "Nessie". Loch Ness is the largest body of fresh water in Great Britain. It's a long, narrow, and deep lake that's about 23 miles; located in the Great Glen, south-west of

Inverness. The word "loch" is Scottish for "lake". The lake's name comes from the River Ness, which flows from the northern end.

On the way, visit **Urquhart Castle**, a ruined castle, located on the shores of Loch Ness in the highlands of Scotland.

Later, continue to Inverness, meaning the mouth of River Ness which is one of the major attractions of the Scottish Highlands. On the way, pass by the **Inverness Castle**. Have a local dinner and check-in to the hotel in Inverness.

Later, return to Inverness. Have dinner and stay overnight in Inverness.



Day 09: 16TH JUNE: INVERNESS – GLENCOE – FORT WILLIAM – LOCH LOMOND CRUISE – GLASGOW By Road

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel and pass by the famous landmarks such as Linlithgow Palace, the mythical Kelpies, and the dramatically perched Stirling Castle (outside visit).

Head north through **Glencoe**. Stop in the **Fort William** area before a short drive to the **Glenfinnan Viaduct**. Because of its depiction in the Harry Potter films, the Glenfinnan Viaduct is commonly referred to as "The Harry Potter Bridge" and attracts hundreds of thousands of tourists each year which has put a significant strain on the small hamlet of Glenfinnan.

Enjoy **Loch Lomond Experience Cruise** and then proceed towards Glasgow. On arrival, visit **Glasgow Cathedral** and enjoy photo stop at **George Square and University of Glasgow** from outside.

Later, have dinner and stay overnight in Glasgow.



Day 10: 17TH JUNE: GLASGOW – CAIRNRYAN – STENA LINE CRUISE – BELFAST By Road & Cruise

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel and proceed to **Cairnryan** to board **Stena Line Cruise to Belfast**.

Upon arrival, embark on the cruise and sail to Belfast, the capital of Northern Ireland. On arrival, proceed to visit **Titanic Museum**. Titanic Belfast is the city's Flagship Titanic experience and describes itself as the world's most authentic retelling of the iconic story. It is a visitor attraction in Northern Ireland, which opened in 2012 - a monument to Belfast's maritime heritage on the site of the former Harland & Wolff shipyard in the city's Titanic Quarter where the RMS Titanic was built. It tells the stories of the Titanic, which hit an iceberg and sank during her maiden voyage in 1912, and her sister ships RMS Olympic and HMHS Britannic.



Next, enjoy an **orientation tour** including Titanic Shipyards, Stormont & Parliament buildings, St. Anne's Cathedral, Crumlin Road Jail & Courthouse, Cathedral quarter etc.

Have dinner and check-in to the hotel at Belfast.

Day 11: 18TH JUNE: BELFAST – CLIFFS OF MOHER – LIMERICK

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel and proceed to **Cliffs of Moher** renowned for their rugged beauty, dramatic cliff sides and diverse birdlife, including puffins, gannets, and guillemots. They have been featured in numerous films and are a popular tourist destination, attracting over a million visitors each year. On a clear day, visitors can see breath-taking views of the Atlantic, Galway Bay and the Aran Islands from the Cliffs of Moher.

Next, proceed to **Limerick**. On arrival, see St. Mary's Cathedral and the medieval King John's Castle(outside), situated on the River Shannon. Stroll along the picturesque **Riverwalk**, enjoying the views of the water and the city's charming bridges.

Then, have dinner in the restaurant and check-in to the hotel in Limerick.

Day 12: 19TH JUNE – LIMERICK – KILLARNEY – RING OF KERRY – GALWAY

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, proceed for a whole day tour to **Ring of Kerry**. Pass through many picturesque villages such as **Glenbeigh, Waterville and Sneem**. The Ring of Kerry is a 179 km (111 mile) scenic route in County Kerry, Ireland. It's a popular driving route that circles the **Iveragh Peninsula** and one of Ireland's main attractions. Rugged and verdant landscapes with views of the Atlantic Ocean along with quaint, rural seaside villages, placid lakes, majestic mountains, mysterious ruins, and charming villages with magnificent natural beauty form the main attraction of this drive. But it's the lovely contrast between the warmth of the people and the elemental nature of the place that makes it so special, and worth slowing down to explore.

Return to **Killarney**, located in south-western Ireland via **Ladies View**, the famous Lakes of Killarney and through the Oakwood's of Killarney's magnificent National Park. Ladies View is a scenic viewpoint on the Ring of Kerry tourist route about **19 kilometres (12 miles) from Killarney** along the N71 road to **Kenmare**.

The gorgeous panorama over the Upper Lake and Purple Mountain at this viewpoint, 17km south of Killarney, was enjoyed by Queen Victoria's ladies-in-waiting in 1861 Killarney is a picturesque town in Ireland known for its natural beauty, rich history and friendly and welcoming people. It is situated on the **Ring of Kerry** making it the perfect home base for exploring numerous attractions.

Later, enjoy dinner and stay overnight in the hotel at Galway.



Day 13: 20TH JUNE: GALWAY – ARAN ISLANDS – DUBLIN

By Road

Day 13

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, proceed to the Port of Galway to board the Aran Islands Cruise.

The Aran Islands are a group of three islands located off the west coast of Ireland in Galway Bay. The largest island is Inishmore, followed by Inishmaan and Inisheer. The Aran Islands are known for their unique culture and language, as well as their breathtaking landscape. The landscape of the islands is made up of rugged limestone formations, and visitors can explore ancient stone walls and fortresses while taking in spectacular views of the Atlantic Ocean. The landscape of the island is distinctive, with miles of stone walls and fissured limestone that stretch out to massive cliffs on the western side of the island. Nature has provided a wave-sculpted coastline, a thriving seal colony, wild swans, ducks, and rare birds, all complementing the ancient ruins and local cafés and restaurants that this island is famous for.

On arrival at Inishmore, board the horse cart or a luxury tourist van (**to be paid on the spot by the guest as per availability as options are very limited**) to roam through the island and visit Dun Aonghasa, The Seven Churches along with visit to the Aran Sweater Market. The largest island, Inishmore, is home to the prehistoric fort of Dún Aonghasa, perched on top of a high cliff. As you travel through this island, the calmness, the roars of the Atlantic waves, the serenity, the lush green fields, the horses in the stables, pretty cottages, the feel of the sea-breeze on the face and the solitude teleports the visitors from the modern hectic schedule of monotonous routine to a different world.

Later, board the ferry and return to the Port of Galway. Journey towards Dublin for an overnight stay after dinner.



Day 14: 21ST JUNE: DUBLIN – AIRPORT

By Road & Flight

Day 14

Meals: Breakfast & Meal on Board

After breakfast, proceed for a guided city tour of Dublin. Pass by the **Dublin Castle, Christ Church Cathedral, St. Patrick's Cathedral & Phoenix Park.**

Visit **Trinity College Dublin**, one of the oldest universities in Ireland and one of the highly ranked international universities of the world that has produced some of the world's famous personalities such as writers namely Oscar Wilde, Samuel Beckett, the political thinker Edmund Burke, scientists William Rowan Hamilton and Ernest Walton, etc. Founded in 1592, the university is located at a beautiful campus in the heart of Dublin's city centre. It is home to 22,000+ undergraduate and postgraduate students studying various disciplines such as Arts and Humanities, Business, Law, Engineering, Health Sciences and Social Sciences; Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics. Inside the university building is housed the **Book of Kells** - a 9th-century gospel manuscript famous throughout the world. Visit Book of Kells "Turning Darkness into Light" exhibition; then to the

Treasury where a volume of the Book of Kells and other related manuscripts are on view. Next, visit the magnificent **Old Library's Long Room** which houses 200,000 of the Library's oldest books in its oak bookcases.

Finish the tour with a visit to **The Guinness Storehouse**. It tells the story of Ireland's most famous export, the Guinness beer, from its humble beginnings in 1759 to its global recognition today. The Storehouse is not only the home of Guinness but also a celebration of Irish culture, creativity and entrepreneurship.

Later, proceed to the airport in the late evening to board the flight back to Kolkata via Dubai/Abu Dhabi.
