Day 01: 8th March, KOLKATA – SINGAPORE

By Flight SQ 517 23:40/06:15 HRS.

Day 02: 9th March, SINGAPORE – AUCKLAND

By Flight & Road SQ 281 08:45/23:35 HRS.

Meals on Board

Reach Singapore in the morning and then board the next connecting flight from Singapore to Auckland.

Auckland is New Zealand's largest city, set between two sparkling harbours and the appealing Hauraki Gulf because of which Auckland is known as the City of Sails. Auckland, located on the North Island metropolis is blessed with a spectacular waterfront, a magnificent skyline and more beaches than many of the country's coastal resorts. Auckland is a multi-cultural urban oasis of food, music, arts and culture. It's where sparkling waters and lush landscapes meet city sophistication. On arrival, complete the immigration formalities before leaving the airport. Hop on to our luxury coach and proceed to the hotel for check-in and stay overnight in Auckland.



Day 2

DAY 03: 10th March, AUCKLAND CITY TOUR – WAITOMO – ROTORUA

By Road

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, proceed for **city orientation tour of Auckland** including visit to the **Auckland Sky Tower** and **Sea Life Kelly Tarlton's Aquarium**.

Drive out to Bastion Point, a coastal piece of land that overlooks the Waitemata Harbour, view the skyline of Auckland and Auckland Harbour Bridge.

Standing prominently in Auckland City, the iconic **Sky Tower** provides a great introduction to the city with panoramic 360 degree views up to 80km in every direction. Take an elevator ride 328 metres high above street level and enjoy views over the city and across to ancient volcanoes, sparkling harbours and beyond.

Next, visit **Sea Life Kelly Tarlton's Aquarium** that showcases over 30 live animal exhibits in spectacular habitat displays, including the southern hemisphere's largest sub-Antarctic penguin colony exhibit and amazing underwater viewing tunnels.

Next, transfer to Waitomo. Enjoy 45-minute guided tour of the world-famous **Waitomo Glow Worm Caves**. An ancient world 30 million years in the making is brought to life by the tour guide through story-telling of its history, features and legends. Get mesmerized on seeing the stunning, delicate cave formations and enjoy a boat ride through the starry wonderland of Arachnocampa Luminosa, thousands of magical glowworms, unique to New Zealand.

Day 4

DAY 04: 11th March, ROTORUA – TE PUIA – AGRODOME – ROTORUA

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, enjoy the Rotorua city orientation tour, including Government Gardens and Lakefront.

Just seven minutes from central Rotorua lies the geothermal valley of Wakarewarewa. Proceed for a visit to **Te Puia** Maori Arts & Crafts Institute and **Pohutu geyser**. Enjoy a 90-minute guided tour through the greenstone, wood carving and flax weaving schools at the Maori Arts and Crafts Institute, the Kiwi Conservation Centre and the geothermal valley and geyser.

After the tour, visit **Agrodome**. Witness a live sheep shearing demonstration and the remarkable farm dogs as they demonstrate their ability to respond to commands and keep those sheep in line.

After the tour, have dinner and return to the hotel for an overnight stay at Rotorua.



DAY 05: 12th March, ROTORUA – AUCKLAND – CHRISTCHURCH

By Flight & Road

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel. There are two possible routes from Rotorua to Auckland. Travel past Hamilton on the main highway (SH1) where the mighty Waikato River will accompany you for much of the journey. Or, travel on the secondary highway (SH27) through small farming towns including Matamata, where the Hobbiton Movie Set provides the area's biggest attraction.

Proceed to **Hobbiton Movie Set (optional)**, hidden on private farmland near the town of Matamata. Here, the village of Hobbiton was carefully created in amazing detail as a film location for The Lord of the Rings and Hobbit movie trilogies. During the two hour walk around the enchanting village your guide will highlight intricate detailing, point out the most famous locations and explain how the movie magic was made.

Reach Auckland airport and board the flight to Christchurch.

Arrive at Christchurch. Set against the majestic backdrops of the Southern Alps and Pacific Ocean, Christchurch is romantically known as New Zealand's Garden City. Edwardian punters, glide down the beautiful Avon River. Historic trams

trundle by the Canterbury Museum, Botanic Gardens and the best of the City's shopping in Cashel, High and Colombo Streets, picture-perfect New Regent Street and the popular Riverside Markets. Renowned for its street art, Christchurch is an ever-changing city buzzing with creativity and flair.

Proceed for an orientation tour of Christchurch. The sightseeing tour covers the city highlights including Canterbury University, Riccarton House and Bush, Hagley Park, Museum and Botanical Gardens etc. Later, have dinner and check-in to the hotel for an overnight stay.

DAY 06: 13th March, CHRISTCHURCH – LAKE TEKAPO / OMARAMA
Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, as you depart from Christchurch, a lush patchwork of flat, green farmlands surrounds you as you traverse through some of the most impressive, braided rivers in the world. En-route, the charming village of Geraldine provides for a convenient halfway refreshment stop. Continue through the vast and impressive landscape to picturesque **Lake Tekapo**. Enjoy a day of lovely road-side scenery. At Lake Tekapo, **The Church of the Good Shepherd** provides a popular photo stop sitting solitary on the shores of the lake, framed by magnificent mountains.

Later, travel to Omarama located in the Waitaki District, in the southern Canterbury region. It is a countryside town close to the Southern Alps, near the southern end of the Mackenzie Basin, in the South Island of New Zealand and a crossroads between Queenstown and Twizel.

Check-in to the hotel in Omarama / Lake Tekapo area followed by dinner and an overnight stay.


DAY 07: 14th March, LAKE TEKAPO/ OMARAMA – MT. COOK – LAKE PUKAKI – QUEENSTOWN

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, depart from Omarama and pass by the fascinating towering pinnacles of the Clay Cliffs from where you will take the southern route through the beautiful and dramatic Lindis Pass and the beautiful Lake Dunstan. The journey then whisks you alongside lakes and rivers through Cromwell, a fruit growing region with beautiful gardens. Traverse the brilliant blue Ohau canal and hug the shores of magnificent **Lake Pukaki** as you travel up the spectacular valley to a rugged land of ice and rock, home to New Zealand's highest mountain, **Aoraki Mount Cook**.

Depart from Mount Cook region and follow the shores of Lake Pukaki towards the sophisticated resort town of **Queenstown**. With its majestic mountains that plunge into crystal clear Lake Wakatipu, Queenstown is a hub of adventure, buzzing with adrenaline and a smorgasbord of outdoor activities. Queenstown is a beautiful town on the Southern Island of New Zealand. Some marvelous and picturesque attractions make Queenstown memorable for a visit, with a backdrop of the southern alps and the stunning Lake Wakatipu.

Have dinner and check-in to the hotel in Queenstown for an overnight stay.

Day 7


DAY 08: 15th March, QUEENSTOWN – MILFORD SOUND CRUISE – QUEENSTOWN

By Road & Cruise

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

After breakfast, follow the southern arm of Lake Wakatipu to Lumsden and onward to Lake Te Anau. Enter the Eglinton Valley and travel through the Homer Tunnel to reach Milford Sound. Arrive at Milford Sound Nature Cruise that offers magnificent views of the Mitre Peak and Bowen Falls. Enjoy a sumptuous Indian lunch buffet while sailing amidst the fjords.

The return journey along the stunning Milford Road scenic highway provides the possibility of stopping for further sightseeing or photo opportunities that may have been missed on the way into Milford. At Te Anau, you'll turn inland to Mossburn, then northwards to the little lakeside settlement of Kingston.

Hug the shores of the beautiful Lake Wakatipu as it meanders beneath the surrounding towering mountains as you take yet another scenic journey into Queenstown.

Later, have dinner and stay overnight in Queenstown.

DAY 09: 16th March, QUEENSTOWN – WANAKA – FRANZ JOSEF AREA (GLACIER REGION)

By Road

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, proceed for a scenic drive between Queenstown and Wanaka, over the mountainous Crown Range and alongside rivers and lakes.

Wanaka is a perfect location for those looking for all the splendour of the southern lakes but a more relaxed ambiance than Queenstown. Enjoy waterfalls and river scenery on the drive up the West Coast, a wild and untamed place famous for its rivers, rainforests, glaciers and geological treasures. At the Gates of Haast, a series of rapids creates a waterfall effect as the racing glacial waters thunder below the road.

Continue a spectacular scenic drive through the lush temperate rainforest to the **glacier regions** of **Fox and Franz Josef**, relics of the last ice age and among the most convenient in the world to visit. Franz Josef is one of the few places in the world where a glacier meets a temperate rainforest.

That contrast is hard to forget. Towering ice, mossy forest, and shifting light, all within walking distance of town. Enjoy photo stops at **Fox Glacier, Franz Josef Glacier and Lake Matheson**.

Check-in to the hotel in **Franz Josef** followed by dinner and an overnight stay.



Day 9



**DAY 10: 17th March, FRANZ JOSEF AREA – HOKITIKA – GREYMOUTH
GREYMOUTH – CHRISTCHURCH**

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel and travel through scenic rainforests and flowing rivers towards **Hokitika**, known for its pounamu (jade, greenstone). This region is steeped in gold and coal mining history and set on a former gold rush site; the replica “Shantytown” is a short detour off the main highway. Sunsets can be magic on the West Coast with the sun going down over the sea and the snow-capped mountains to the east tinged with a rosy, soft pink glow.

Next, report to the Greymouth Railway Station to board the **TranzAlpine Scenic Train** from Greymouth to Christchurch. Described as one of the great train journeys in the world, the TranzAlpine travels from coast to coast across the mountainous spine of the South Island past aqua blue rivers and through vast patchwork plains. Crossing from coast to coast in New Zealand's South Island, the Transalpine is one of the world's most spectacular train journeys. Cross fertile farmlands and enjoy the majesty of the chiselled alpine landscape as you travel the edges of the ice-fed Waimakariri River and through miles of unique native beech forests. Witness epic vistas and the striking beauty of the mighty Southern Alps.

Arrive at Christchurch railway station and transfer to the restaurant for dinner. Then, proceed to the hotel for check-in and stay over night in Christchurch.
